

7.3 Institutional Distinctiveness of the session 2015-16

Area of distinctiveness: Infrastructural Development

Our institution has always strived to upgrade the facilities and amenities provided to the students and infrastructural development is an integral part of it. Keeping in mind the increasing number of departments offering new Honours and General courses to the students, the college authority has invested in the construction of a new building in the same premises. As the old building did not have enough space for expansion, all college operations have been shifted to the new building this year onwards. The new college building has more number of classrooms that are spacious and comfortable. Several laboratories with adequate equipment and resources have been created along with audio-visual rooms with projectors to impart practical and ICT-based education to the students. Provision for further expansion in future has been made to accommodate the growing number of courses and student strength. A spacious library with test books, reference books, journals and access to e-resources is also a part of the new building. Separate common rooms for male and female students with indoor games facility have been created so that students can spend some leisure time after class hours and interact with each other. The G+4 college building has an elevator for staff members and students to facilitate movement between the floors and a wheelchair ramp has been created for the disabled. The office space has also been expanded to increase administrative efficiency. The new college building is modern, well-equipped, spacious, and provides a conducive environment for the holistic development of the students. Efforts have been made to convert the premises into a 'green campus' with plenty of greenery and garden space.
