

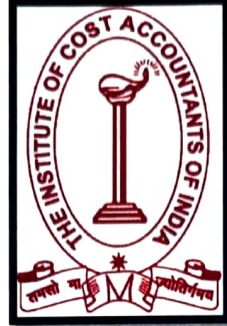

TARADEVI HARA KHCHAND KANKARIA JAIN COLLEGE, affiliated to University of Calcutta situated at 6, Ram Gopal Ghosh Road, Cossipore, Kolkata-700002 represented through its **Principal, Dr. Mausumi Singh Sengupta**, (which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to include its successors in office, representative, administrators, and assigns) of the **SECOND PART**.


Whereas both the Institutions (**THE INSTITUTE OF COST ACCOUNTANTS OF INDIA & TARADEVI HARA KHCHAND KANKARIA JAIN COLLEGE**) have identified the following areas of mutual co-operations:

Conducting "GST Course - College & University Students" at **TARADEVI HARA KHCHAND KANKARIA JAIN COLLEGE**,

- (i) Campus for students of Commerce, Banking & Insurance & Allied Courses. The Syllabus, terms and conditions are prescribed in the Annexure – 1.
- (ii) Conducting various joint Seminars & Workshops
- (iii) Conducting other certificate programs (i.e. Skill Based Tailor-made courses) on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

Renewal, Review, Revenue Sharing, Termination etc.:

- (i) This MoU shall be valid initially for a period of one year and may be extended further on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
- (ii) This MoU shall be subjected to review each year by both the Institutions jointly.




- (iii) This MoU may be terminated upon mutual understanding serving a notice of 90 (Ninety) days in advance.
- (iv) Neither **THE INSTITUTE OF COST ACCOUNTANTS OF INDIA** nor **TARADEVI HARAKHCHAND KANKARIA JAIN COLLEGE**, will charge any other commission/fees from each other, other than the fees for the course which will be collected by **TARADEVI HARAKHCHAND KANKARIA JAIN COLLEGE**, and deposited in the bank account of **THE INSTITUTE OF COST ACCOUNTANTS OF INDIA**.

Miscellaneous Provisions:

- (i) The Memorandum of understanding (MOU) as outlined in this document is not intended to be a legally binding document. Rather, it is meant to describe the nature and cooperative intentions of the Institute and **TARADEVI HARAKHCHAND KANKARIA JAIN COLLEGE**, to suggest guidelines for cooperation. 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


Learning Materials :
