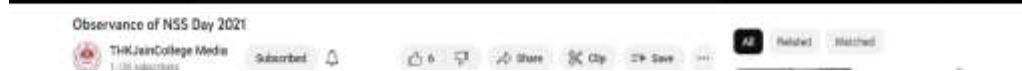
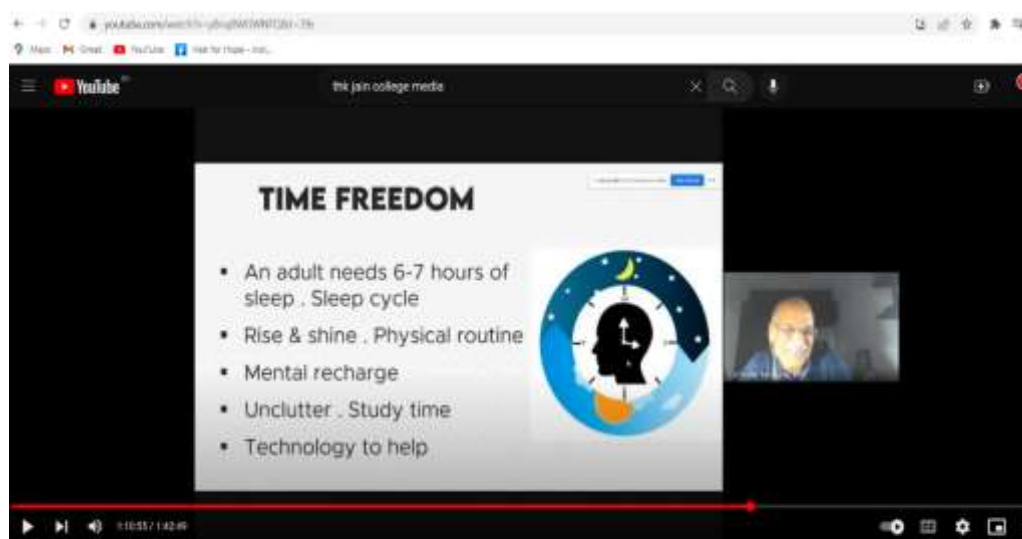


5.1.3 Capacity building and skills enhancement initiatives taken by the institution include the following:

The following programs on capacity building and skill enhancement, were organized by the College in the session 2021-2022:

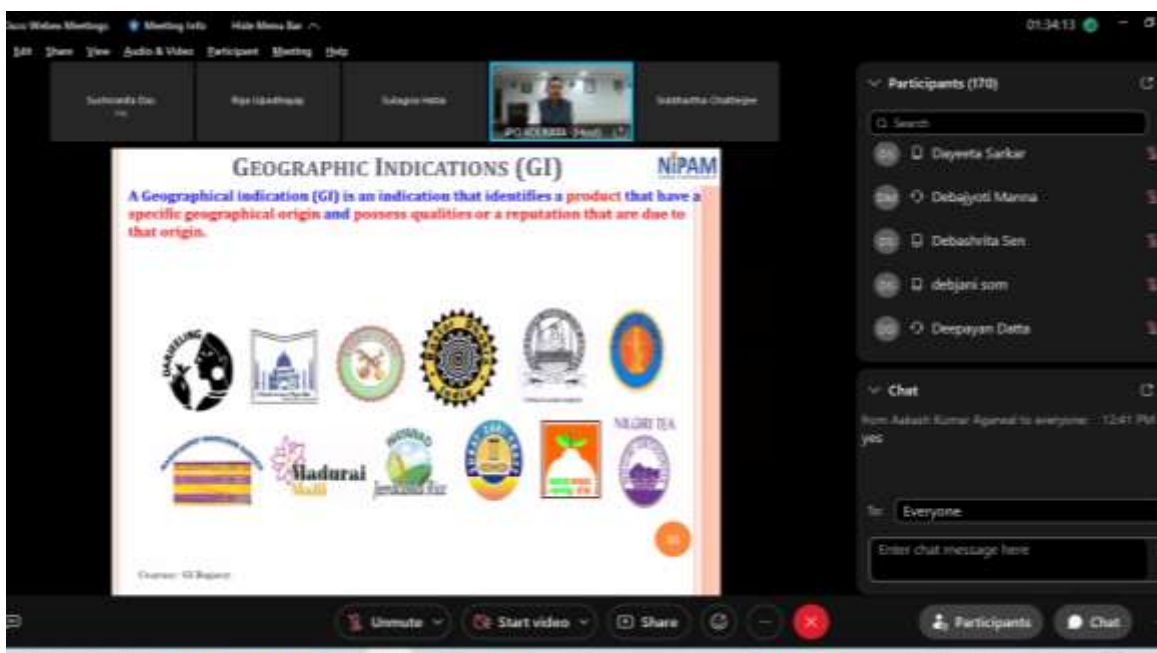
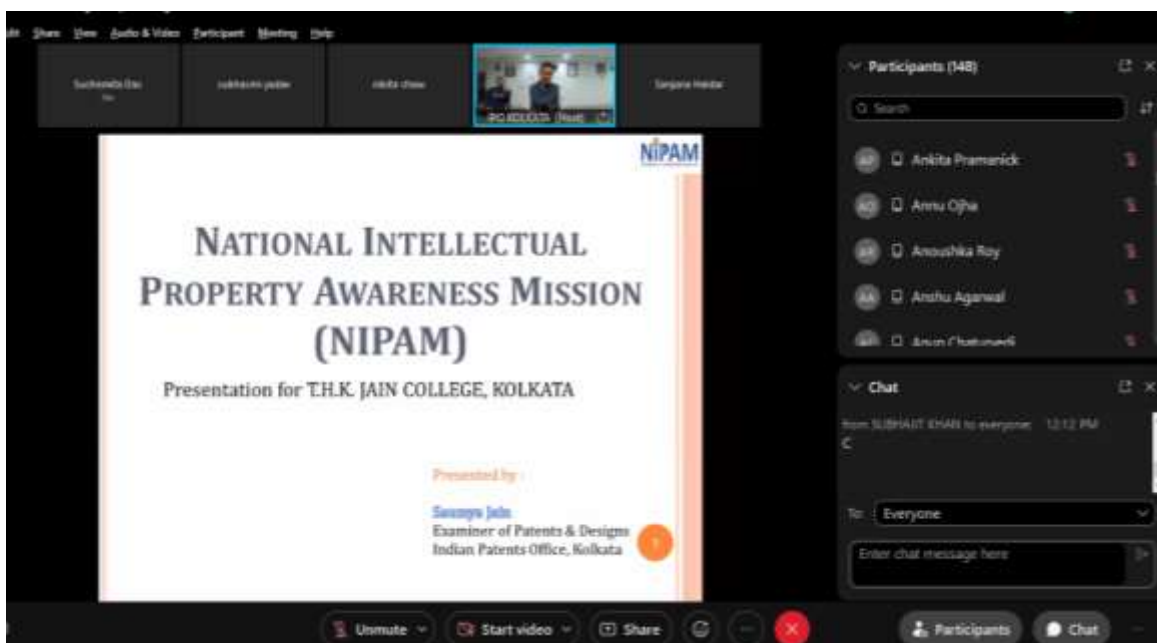
- **Webinar on Life Skill: 'Tough Times don't last; Tough People Do' (24th Sept, 2021)**

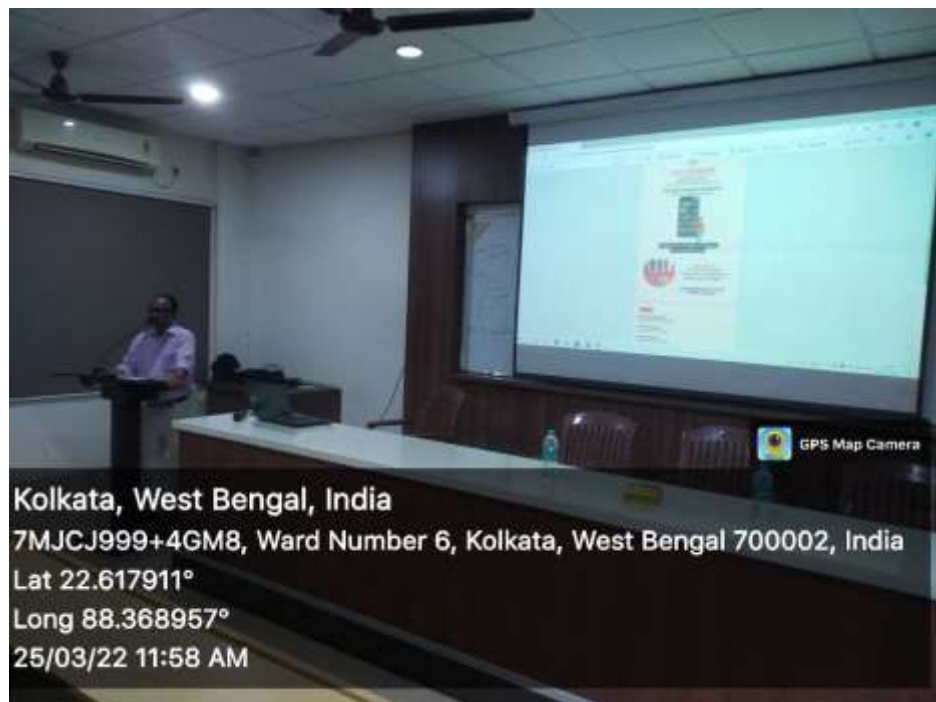

On the first day of training, girls learnt the basic techniques of martial art and self-defence and they also performed drill under the supervision of Mr. Iqbal Ahmed and trainers Smt. Manasi Ghorai and Smt. Rosina Khaton. The students were taught the Oath of Tejashwini. Further, elaborate trainings were held in the subsequent days.

The *finale* was held at the Police Athletic Club (PAC) Maidan tent ground. The final day programme was inaugurated by Smt.
