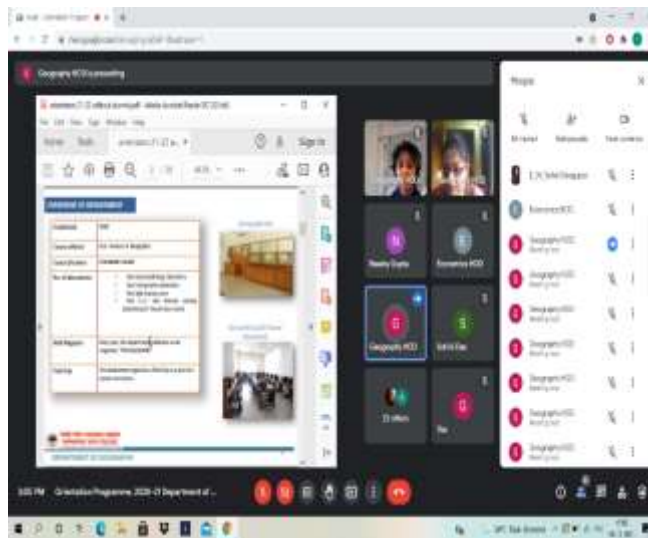

The teachers are encouraged to prepare PowerPoint presentations on the curriculum, PO-CO of the programs and prospects of the subject being taken by the students in their UG course.

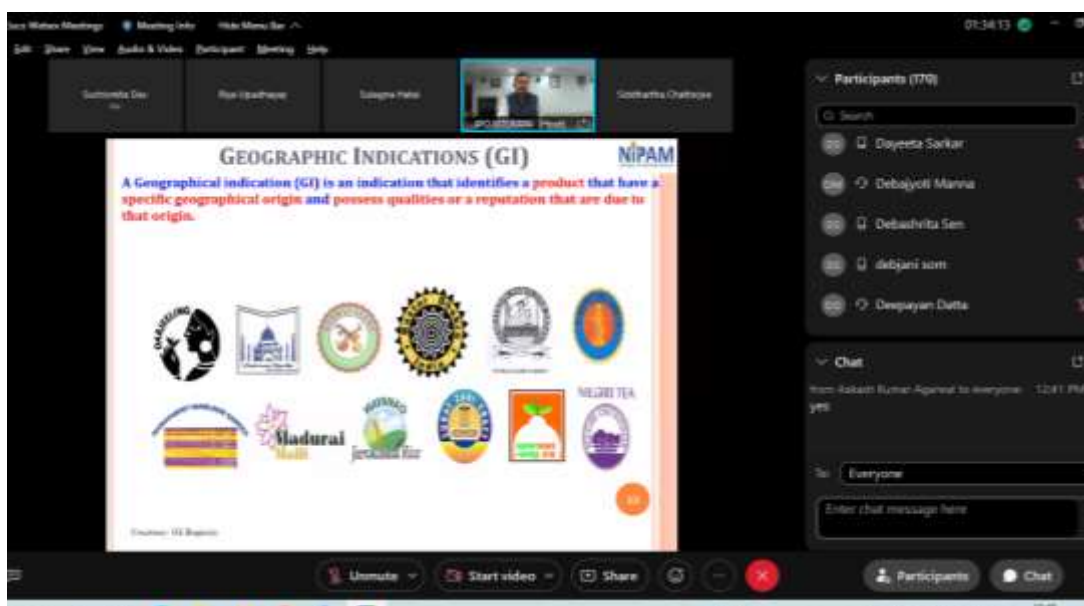

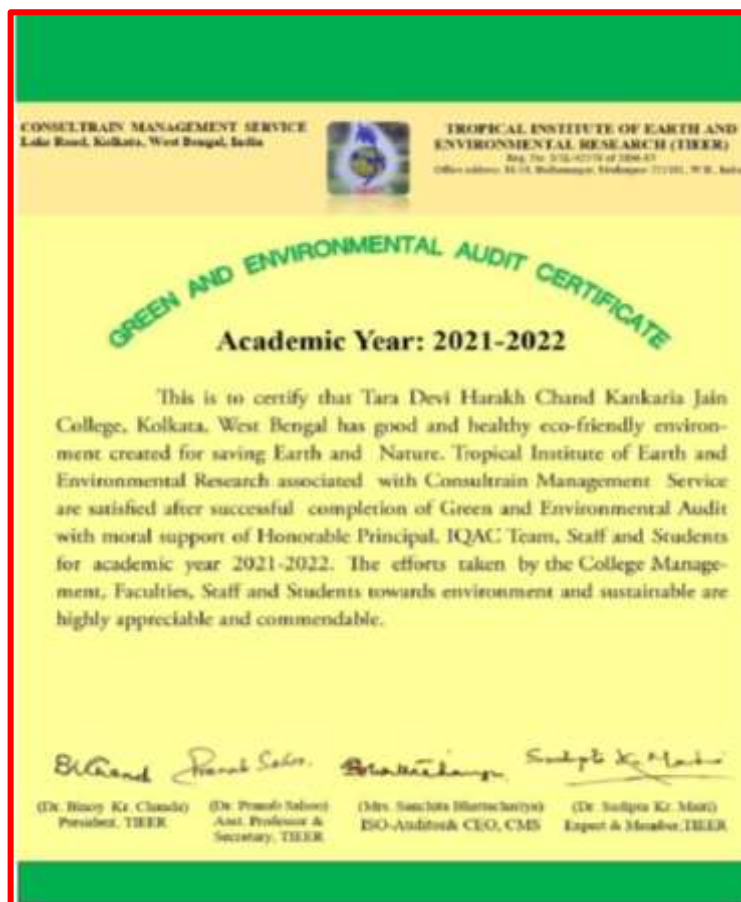

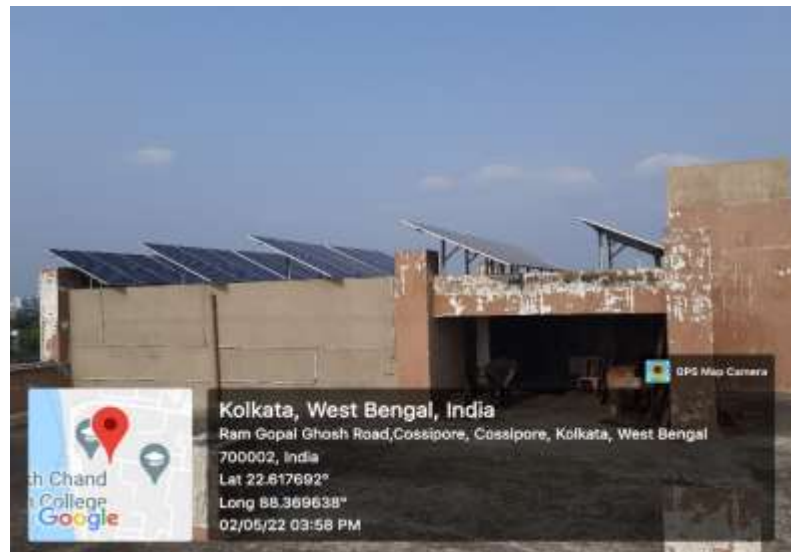


The Green and Environmental Audit Certificate
