

## The College has taken utmost care for making the campus lush green and eco-friendly campus:

- There are lawns, playing ground with green trees planted on the side and pedestrian pathways where the students spend their free-time
- The kitchen wastes and fallen leaves are collected and are used for composting. In six months, around 100 kgs of manure has been generated; used for gardening purposes
- College has a medicinal plant garden, nectar nursery, specimen garden
- Roof-top Solar panel for conservation of energy (30 KWp DC Grid connected Rooftop Turnkey Solar Photovoltaic Project)
- Water reservoir for collecting rain water to use for gardening and cleaning (re-use of water)
- The college has also taken the initiatives to stop the use of plastics and tobacco inside the campus. Banners/stickers are displayed in different location of the campus (including canteen) for bringing awareness amongst the students and staff
- Separate garbage bins have been kept for disposal of biodegradable and nonbiodegradable wastes




