
Teachers Feedback Report

Following are the observations from the feedback:

Teachers:

The scores obtained are average as the teachers find the syllabus quite extensive and difficult to complete within the span available for each semester. However, teachers are satisfied with the ambience of the institution.

Alumni

The scores given by alumni are good and they are satisfied with the curriculum and the academic performance/ambience of the institution. However, they believe that the syllabus is not joboriented and not very helpful for qualifying state/national level entrance examinations at the PG level. They want more ICT-based classes and attention for weaker students.

• Students:

The scores obtained from the students are high in almost every parameter, including curriculum and ambience of the institution, except for the following parameters:

- ICT-based classes
- Library facilities
- Internships/field visits/student exchange opportunities organized by college
- Attention for academically weaker students





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Action taken report:

- The librarian was instructed to enhance library facilities and purchase more books that will guide the students to qualify for various competitive examinations related to job and PG-entrance examinations
- The departments were informed to organize more visits (field/lab/industry) to make the learning process for the students more participative, interesting and engaging
- The teachers were informed to take remedial classes and give more attention to weaker students
- More classrooms were equipped with LCD projector and smart classrooms to be set-up from next session
